We have procured one of WA's largest mobile hi-rail fleets to meet the contractual requirements of major projects where maintenance works must be performed from the track.

Our fleet is built on trusted brands like Liebherr, Hydrema and Doosan. This means your project can be completed faster, with greater accuracy and ultimately a better result.

## TRACK REPAIR SOLUTIONS

### MOBILE FLASH BUTT WELDING

With the only narrow head switch welder of its kind in Australia, our team can build and install a complete turnout without a single aluminothermic weld, delivering transformational improvements on all conventional track maintenance and repair projects.

### UNDERCUTTING AND BALLAST RENEWALS

We are equipped to handle projects of any scale, from small spot undercutting to full ballast renewal for plain lines and turnouts. We utilise state-of-the-art machinery, including Liebherr hi-rail with Trimble GPS systems, loaders, Hydrema hi-rail tippers, and high-quality undercutting bars.

### DE-STRESSING

We have successfully de-stressed thousands of kilometres of track in some of the harshest conditions in Australia. With our automated clipping and de-clipping attachments and advanced technology we can successfully complete rail adjustment works with a 20% reduction in traditional resources.

### RE-RAIL

Our top-of-the-line machinery allows us to deliver rail and sleeper replacement works with a low labour model. PRM is renowned for developing unique methodologies to address site challenges – including hard to reach locations, restricted rail corridors and live operational environments.

### TRACK RESURFACING

We self-perform the full scope of resurfacing support services, from supervision and labour to the provision of specialised tooling, plant and equipment. Whether it's maintaining existing tracks or fine-tuning newly constructed railways, we can address misalignment and strengthen ballast consolidation beneath the rails.

Recognised at the Australasian Rail Industry Awards, our smart track laying system allows for simultaneous lifting and placement of sleepers by a single operator, a task previously requiring rail surveyors and multiple rail technicians.

### NEW TRACK CONSTRUCTION

We understand the complexities and demands of rail track construction in challenging environments like the Pilbara. Our experienced crews are equipped to manage construction of every aspect of rail infrastructure, from ballasting and resurfacing to rail and sleeper laying and welding.

### TRACK RENEWALS

Worn and damaged railway tracks are a critical issue that needs swift attention. We implement efficient, cost-effective solutions designed to work around your operations, minimising downtime and accommodating your operational needs.

### TURNOUT RENEWAL

Maximise asset lifespan and enhance the safety and reliability of your rail network. Using our Narrow Head Flashbutt Welding truck, we can assemble and install entire railway turnouts without any aluminothermic welds, which guarantees stronger, more durable joints and superior overall quality.

### LEVEL CROSSING RENEWALS

Historically, clients needed to engage two separate contractors to complete rail and civil works. At PRM, we can perform both scopes thanks to our extensive machinery fleet and highly trained teams in both disciplines. This reduces project administration and costs for our clients.

### ACCESS ROAD MAINTENANCE

We have a team of skilled operators experienced in maintaining the roads we drive on every day. Combining this with high-quality equipment, we ensure a high rate of production that keeps road users safe and driving-related risks to a minimum.

### SPECIALISED HI-RAIL DRAIN CLEANING

We provide scheduled maintenance cleaning and full-scale drain refurbishment. Our teams can manage and coordinate large scale shutdowns or short track possessions in between train movements. Modern equipment with emergency off-track systems ensure minimal disruption to rail traffic during even the shortest maintenance windows.



# PROTECTING OUR ENVIRONMENT



We are committed to reducing our environmental footprint and protecting the unique ecosystems of the Pilbara. The natural landscape of the Pilbara is known for its stark beauty and we are proud to call it our home.

We support our clients in their journeys towards Net Zero or Real Zero – we deeply care about the future of our planet and are committed to working in close partnership with our clients to ensure we deliver excellence in service whilst meeting important environmental targets.

At PRM, we believe every small action can contribute towards a greener future. We align our sustainability efforts with the Paris Agreement, doing our part to help reduce global emissions and combat climate change. By making simple, everyday changes, we reduce waste, conserve energy and rethink how we work to create a more sustainable future.

Some of the changes we've already made include:

## ADVANCED TECHNOLOGIES AND INNOVATION

Our innovation champions are continually researching how we can decrease our environmental footprint – whether that's through small changes or developing cutting-edge technologies. In 2023 we deployed our 'hydration station' – harnessing renewable energy from the hot Pilbara sun to keep our teams hydrated on site without the need for diesel powered refrigeration. Just one small example of how we are embracing renewable energy in our journey towards a greener future.

## TRANSITION TO LOWER-EMISSION EQUIPMENT

We procure technologically advanced equipment with environmental features such as Tier 4-rated engines, which use up to 30% less diesel with the addition of Adblue.

## OFF-GRID SOLAR POWERED SITE FACILITIES

PRM has partnered with Red Rock Services, an Aboriginal-led Pilbara-based business, to procure fully off grid 12x9 solar-powered site offices. These units save approximately 6,000L of diesel fuel per month.

## SWITCHING TO LED LIGHTS

A small but effective change, we continue to transition to LED lighting at our headquarters, which use less energy and have longer lifespans than traditional incandescent bulbs resulting in energy savings and lower emissions.





## INVESTED IN INGENUITY
